^b Dates begin at 0000 UTC and include all tropical and subtropical cyclone stages; non-tropical stages are excluded.

^c Deaths occurring as a direct result of the forces of the tropical cyclone are referred to as “direct” deaths. These would include those persons who drowned in storm surge, rough seas, rip currents, and freshwater floods. Direct deaths also include casualties resulting from lightning and wind-related events (e.g., collapsing structures).
